At Olivine Clinic, safeguarding is at the heart of everything we do. We are fully committed to protecting the welfare of all our patients — adults, children, and young people — and to creating a clinic environment that is safe, respectful, and caring.

Our Commitment

- We believe that everyone who visits our clinic has the right to be protected from harm, abuse, neglect, or exploitation.
- Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility from clinical staff to administrators, visiting practitioners, and contractors.
- We promote a culture of openness, compassion, and vigilance so that any concern is recognised and acted upon quickly.
- We work in partnership with local safeguarding teams, including Dorset Council, the Dorset Safeguarding Adults Board, and the Dorset Safeguarding Children Partnership, to ensure that concerns are handled appropriately and confidentially.

When You Visit the Clinic

You can expect:

- A safe and welcoming space where dignity, privacy, and respect are upheld.
- Staff who are trained to **recognise and respond** to safeguarding concerns.
- Robust systems to ensure your information is handled sensitively and shared only when necessary to protect your wellbeing.
- Chaperones available for any consultation or procedure where you would feel more comfortable with one present.
- Swift action if a patient, child, or vulnerable person is at risk of harm.
